THE TEN COMMANDMENTS (DECALOGUE)

1 And God spoke all these words, saying,

ENDING HUMAN LIFE IS GOD'S PREROGATIVE

NOT JUST MURDER

CRUELTY / VIOLENCE

ANGER, HATRED & CONTEMPT

Jesus said, "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder; and whoever murders will be liable to judgment.' Jesus said, "It was also said, 'Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.' But I say to you that everyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of sexual immorality, makes her commit adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery."

- Matthew 5:31-32

THERE'S ALWAYS FAULT IN 'NO-FAULT DIVORCE'

BUT DIVORCE IS NOT AN UNFORGIVABLE SIN

PROHIBITION OF DIVORCE = CALL TO DISCIPLESHIP

SACREDNESS OF SEX

SEX IS FOR MARRIAGE ONLY

GOD IS PRO-SEX

SEX IS NOT JUST PHYSICAL

Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

- Genesis 2:24

SEX SHOULD BE DIRECTED BY LOVE

FALSE TRAILS

SEX OUTSIDE OF MARRIAGE (FORNICATION)

Now the works of the flesh are obvious: fornication, impurity, licentiousness. - Galatians 5:19

HOMOSEXUALITY

For this reason God gave them up to dishonorable passions. For their women exchanged natural relations for those that are contrary to nature; and the men likewise gave up natural relations with women and were consumed with passion for one another, men committing shameless acts with men. - Romans 1:26-27

SEXUAL LUST: IT'S WHAT YOU DO WITH IT THAT MATTERS

LUST = ANY OBSESSION OF THE MIND

ALL ADDICTIVE BEHAVIORS

Eighth Commandment: "You shall not steal."
BIBLICAL VIEW = STEWARDSHIP, NOT OWNERSHIP

To one he gave five talents, to another two, to another one, to each according to his ability... - Matthew 25:15

SACREDNESS OF STEWARDSHIP

Let the thief no longer steal, but rather let him labor, doing honest work with his own hands, so that he may have something to share with anyone in need. - Ephesians 4:28

WAYS OF STEALING

THEFT OF TIME

CASHING IN ON ANOTHER'S NEED

A full and fair weight you shall have, a full and fair measure you shall have, that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.

- Deuteronomy 25:15

STEALING FROM GOD

For all things come from you, and of your own have we given you. - 2 Chronicles 29:14

Every tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the trees, is the Lord's; it is holy to the Lord. If a man wishes to redeem some of his tithe, he shall add a fifth to it... - Leviticus 27:30-32

LEAVING DEBTS UNPAID

MAKE AMENDS

Ninth Commandment: "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor." SACREDNESS OF TRUTH

FALSE WITNESS

WHY LIE?

FOR SOMEONE'S DETRIMENT = MALICE

TO IMPRESS = PRIDE

OTHER REASONS...

LYING IS NOT OF GOD

Jesus said, "When the devil lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies."

- John 8:44

Question: Is it ever okay to lie?

ALL ABOUT LOVING YOU NEIGHBOR

Tenth Commandment: "You shall not covet..."

Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. - Colossians 3:5

COVETING IS THE ROOT OF ALL SOCIAL EVIL

CALL TO CONTENTMENT

But godliness with contentment is great gain, for we brought nothing into the world, and we cannot take anything out of the world. But if we have food and clothing, with these we will be content. But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation, into a snare, into many senseless and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction. - 1 Timothy 6:6-9

TRUE CONTENTMENT FLOWS ONLY FROM CHRIST

ENEMY TO CONTENTMENT: WORRY

Jesus said, "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on..." - Matthew 6:25

CONTENTMENT FOSTERED BY PRAISE OF GOD

Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?" - Hebrews 13:5-6

IN CONCLUSION...

GOD FIRST, OTHERS SECOND, SELF LAST

PROMISE OF FULFILLMENT MAKES OBEDIENCE TO GOD'S LAW DESIRABLE

PARADOX: FULFILLMENT ONLY KNOWN FROM THE INSIDE

THE "YOU" OF THE TEN COMMANDMENTS WAS PLURAL

WE ARE ONLY MADE LIKE CHRIST THROUGH CHRIST

"Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you clean the outside of the cup and the plate, but inside they are full of greed and self-indulgence. ²⁶ You blind Pharisee! First clean the inside of the cup and the plate, that the outside also may be clean. - Matthew 23:25-26

Spiritual Principle & Practice to help us live the life God intends for us...

God is sovereign over all the world and anything that could come our way in life, over forces that we are powerless over. And God is good. Principle #1:

Turn control of my whole life over to the care of God and His direction, every day: including my relationships, my Practice #1:

finances, my plans, my choices, my day

God created us to receive our sense of value & identity and to hold him responsible for our needs, rather than Principle #2a:

from other people.

Look to God, rather than other people, for my sense of value and identity. Practice #2a:

Principle #2b: In Christ, I am a beloved child of God.

Receive and live in the truth that I am a beloved child of God, who wants to cares for my needs. Practice #2b:

God's intention is to transform me more and more into the likeness of Christ Principle #3:

Open ourselves up to and cooperate with God's process of transformation Practice #3:

Insofar as it depends on us, we are to live at peace with everyone. Principle #4:

Practice #4a: Confess our sin to another

Take responsibility for the wrongs we've done to others, when to do so will not cause further harm Practice #4b:

Surrender past grievances unto God, forgiving others for the wrongs they've done to us Practice #4c:

Principle 5:	You must go down in order to go up. Fulfillment is found in serving others. In order to experience God's love, we must continue giving it away. Guidelines for Writing a Spiritual Autobiography for Confirmands, Receptions, and Reaffirmations in the Diocese of San Joaquin

The Bishop's usual practice is to try and meet in person with candidates for Confirmation, Reception, or Reaffirmation prior to the laying on of hands service, in order to hear from them – in their own words – the story of their faith thus far and why they want to take this step in their faith. However, from time to time and in certain years, this type of one-on-one meeting will not be possible.

In order to be certain that the Bishop is still able to get to know the candidates, he requires that each candidate write a brief spiritual autobiography, with the help of their sponsors and/or clergy. The following are some minimum guidelines (not exhaustive) for the types of information a spiritual autobiography of this sort should provide:

- What is your faith background? Did you grow up in a Christian home environment, some other faith, or with no faith at all?
- When did you begin your relationship with Jesus? Has it been ongoing since your baptism as an infant, or were you older?
- What impact has following Jesus had on your life? What role has your faith played in your day-to-day activities, whether school, work, or social/recreational?
- What do you think Confirmation is, and why is being Confirmed/Received or Reaffirming your faith something you want to do right now
- What does being an Anglican mean to you?
- Do you believe the Nicene Creed? Why is it important?

Again, these are just some minimum guidelines for the types of things that should be included in the spiritual autobiography. These autobiographies should be in the Bishop's possession no later than two weeks prior to the date of Confirmation/Reception/Reaffirmation.
